BACK COUNTRY ACCIDENTS – WHAT YOU NEED TO DO!!

1. Basic bush first aid and survival
2. What to expect when rescue has been activated – PLB, phone, then helicopter, winching etc etc.
3. What the patient can do to assist with the heli evac.
4. A hands on exercise in first aid – maybe splinting, bleeding control, CPR or whatever you feel best.

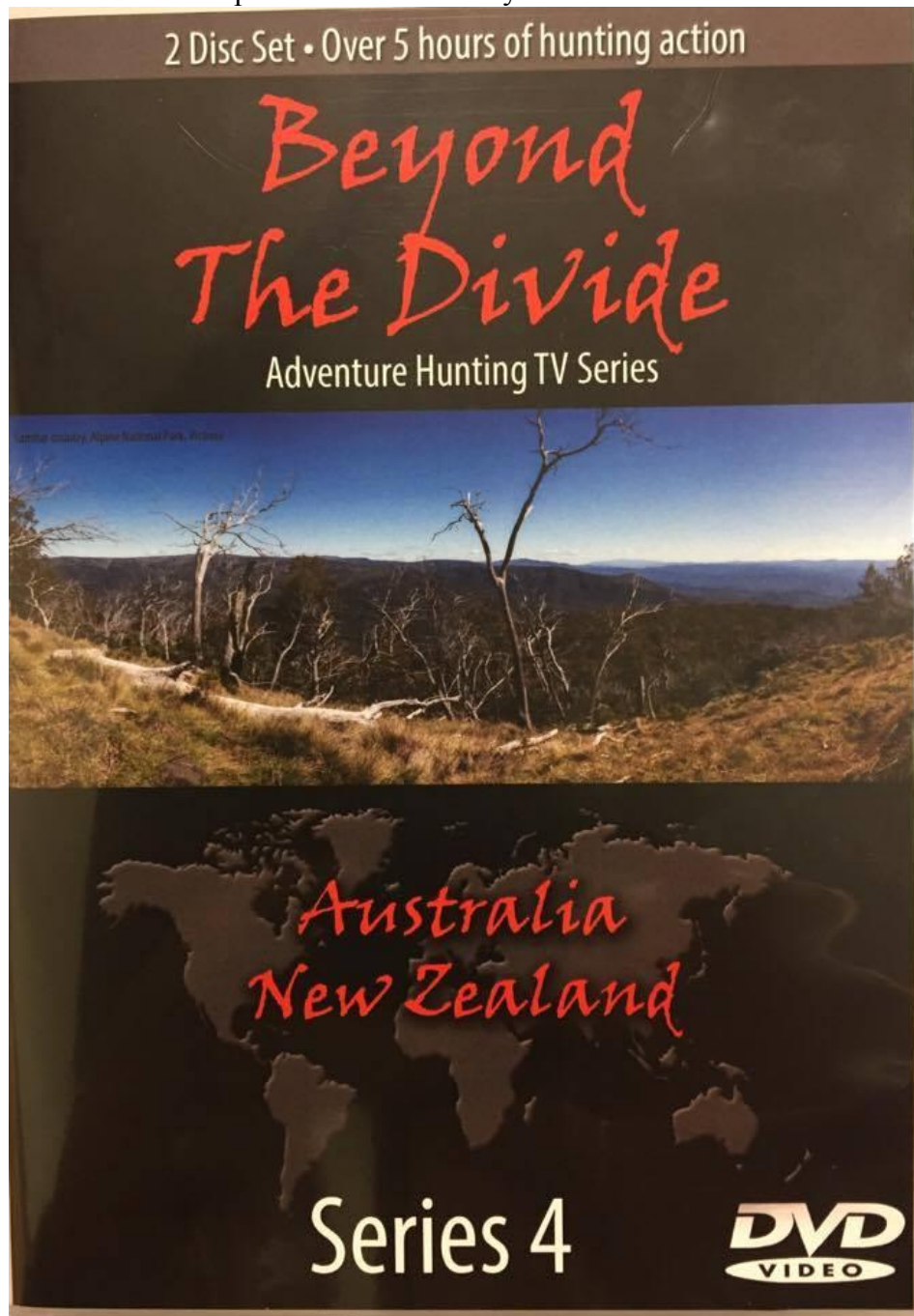


Project Kaka
